Have you ever had the desire to be a part of hands-on patient care? Does the career of a Certified Medical Assistant (CMA) interest you? Kalispell Regional Healthcare is offering tuition scholarships (\$10,000) for this 18 month course at Flathead Valley Community College. Classes begin in August 2017.

The following requirements apply:

1. Individual must shadow at one of Kalispell Regional Healthcare's clinics for a minimum of two hours.
2. Provide a cover letter, resume and transcripts if applicable, outlining your desired path to becoming a Certified Medical Assistant. Submit to Laurie O'Leary, KRH Human Resource Department by June 30th, 2017.
3. Upon completion of course, individual must commit to three years of working as a CMA, with Kalispell Regional Healthcare.
